HOSTING: TEACHING THE WORLD TO FORGIVE

Two Goals

1. To train helpers such as: clergy, chaplains, counselors, psychologists, and coaches to lead people to a place of forgiveness.
2. To provide retreats where people, burdened by resentment, can come and actually engage the forgiveness process.

Two Programs

1. Friday Program: Professional development and training: 9:00 - 4:00 pm.
Participants will be taught how to lead someone to a place of sustainable forgiveness.
Cost per person: \$175 or \$150 per person if you bring a colleague.
2. Saturday Program: Personal Forgiveness Healing Retreat: 9:30 - 3:30 pm.
Participants will engage in the forgiveness exercises to find personal forgiveness and healing. The specific process can be done without others nothing who, or for what, someone is being forgiven.
Cost per person: \$75

Notes for Both Programs

Costs include a boxed or catered lunch budgeted at \$10 per person.

No accommodation is included for participants.

Participant costs may be adjusted depending on sponsorship or other local circumstances.

Timing can be modified to suit local requirements and conditions.

Hosting Requirements

A Parish Hall that could comfortably seat at least 20 people at tables.

Kitchen facilities to provide coffee/water/ and enable a catered "boxed lunch" or simple soup/salad/sandwich lunch.

Easy access and parking for commuter transportation.

Promotional relationships and access to attract a minimum of 20 people per program.

Hosting Costs

The Appreciative Way's financial requirements are to make at least \$5000 per two day program which includes all travel and accommodation costs. This requires a minimum of 20 people per program.

Any additional income will be split equally between The Appreciative Way and the Host organization.

Administration

Registration Process: The Appreciative Way can provide online registration and payment services.

Promotional Materials: The Appreciative Way will provide promotional brochures and email notices to aid the host in promoting the event.
